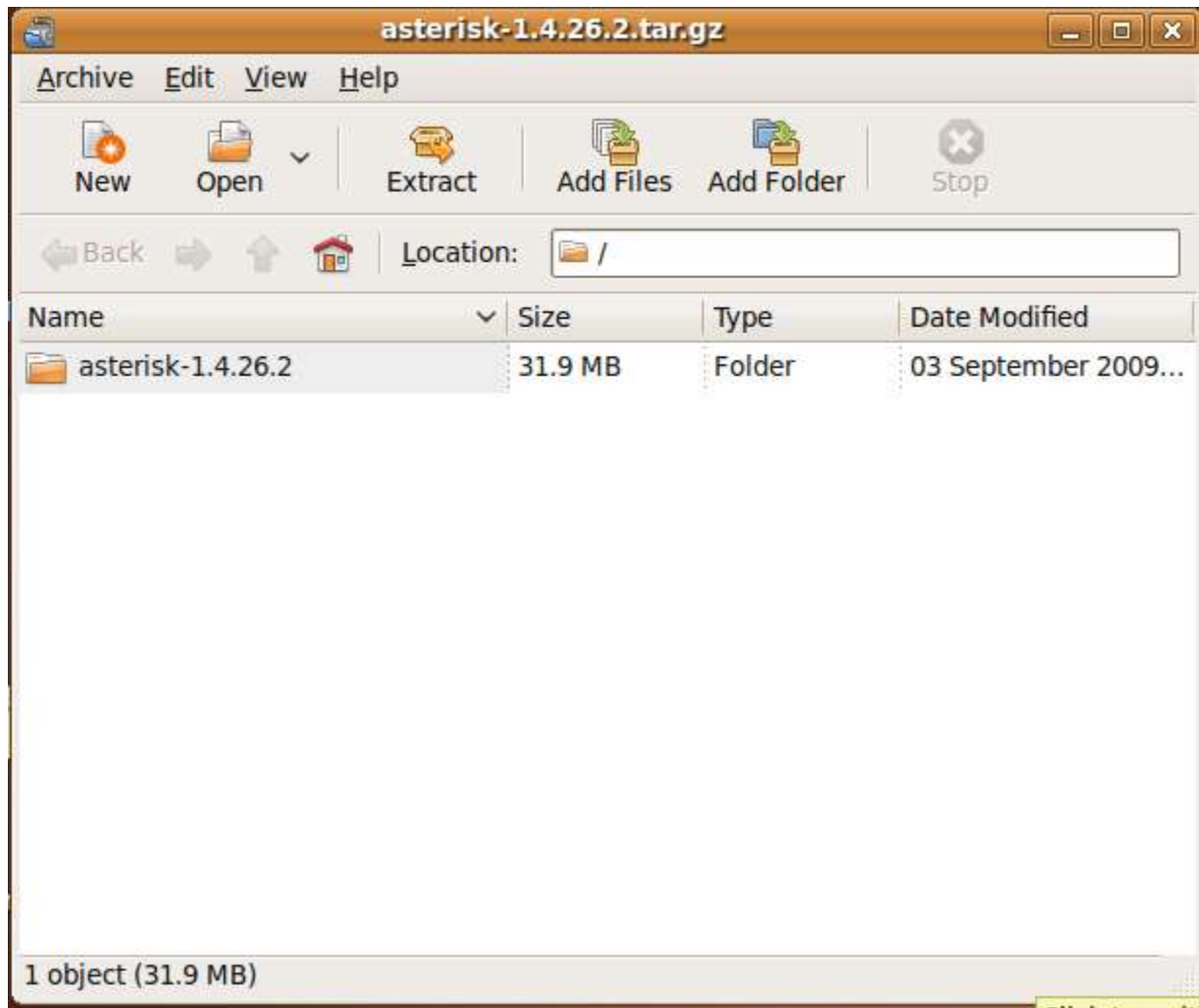

Figure 1. Asterisk download



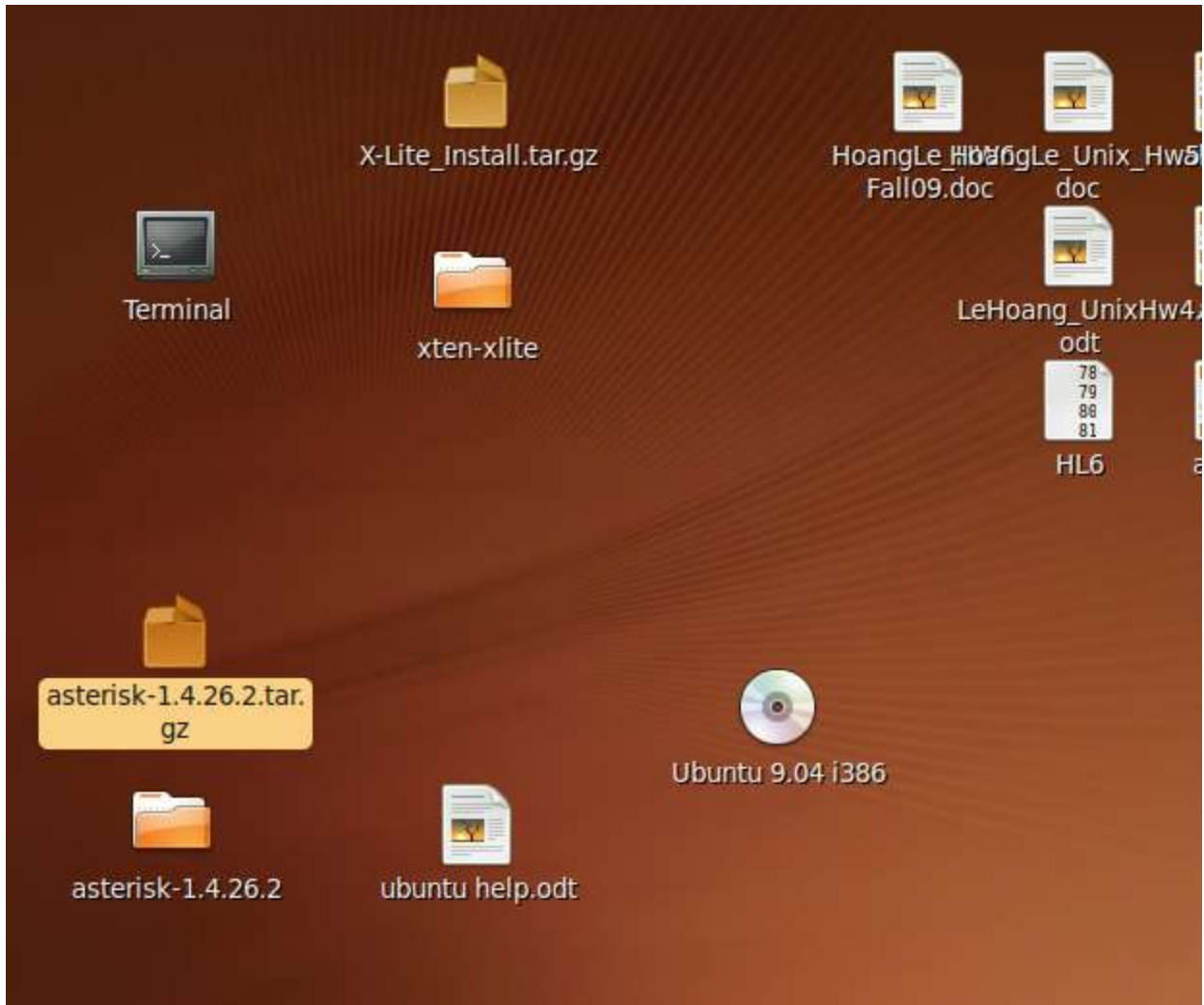

Figure 2. Asterisk 1.4.26.2 successfully downloaded on desktop




